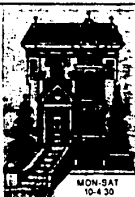


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BRIDGE

The hand in the diagram was played a few months ago at a local duplicate game. Four hearts was the most frequent contract. Three notrump was tried six of 24 times and succeeded half the time. Four hearts was defeated 17 times.

Both Vulnerable
West Deals
West pass North pass East pass South pass
West led the ace of spades.
The bidding shown is natural but a scientific expert might have bid three diamonds on the second round leaving open the possibility of three notrump.

Four hearts is a good contract. South can expect to lose one spade and two clubs.
Equally obvious, the game should be defeated for as the cards lie, West has a sure trump trick. Whenever a club was led, South had no chance, but many defenders chose another lead and declarer might have made the contract.

It is normal not to lead the club for it simply uses up West's natural trump trick.
At several tables, West led the ace of spades in the hope of forcing declarer to ruff and thereby weaken the trumps. Dummy showed this to be hopeless, so a diamond was led to dummy's singleton ace.

Two rounds of trumps told the bad news. Declarer can now win the diamond king and ruff a diamond. He now should play two high spades ending in dummy and lead a small club.

At this point each hand has five cards and East has one diamond and four clubs. If East makes the mistake of playing the king or queen, one of declarer's losers disappears.

East can lead a diamond and give declarer a ruff and discard or a club into dummy's ace-ten.

The defense isn't easy. If East stops to think, he should play low. He is in trouble in any event if South has the club jack.
