









## Getting Started on an **Android Device**

# 1

### Download the Overdrive app

- Open the Google Play app store 
- Tap on the search bar: 
- Search for **Overdrive**
- Tap on the Overdrive app icon 
- Tap **Install**  then tap **Accept** 
- The app will begin downloading. Once it has downloaded tap **Open** 


# 2

### Create your Overdrive account

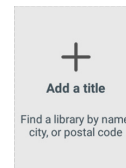
- Tap **Sign Up** 
- Either enter your details and set a new password or sign up using your library card number
- Tap **Sign Up** to create your account

# 3

### Sign into Metronet using your Library card





- Click **Add a Title** (Figure A)
- Search for **Farmington Community Library** and choose it from the list
- Tap **Metronet Library Consortium**
- Tap **Sign In** 
- Select **Farmington Public Library** from the list of libraries and enter your card number
- Tap **Sign In**

### Download up to 10 e-books and e-audiobooks per month

- Search for any title using the **search bar** at the top of the page 
- Tap on the cover of the title that you would like to check out
- Tap **Borrow** or **Borrow for 21 days**
- Tap **Go To Loans** 
- Tap **Add To App** 
- The title can be accessed by tapping the menu button  in the upper left corner and tapping **Bookshelf**
